On August 28-31, 2018 the Polish Neuroscience Society had its 13th International Congress dedicated to the 100th Anniversary of the Nencki Institute of Experimental Biology in Warsaw. ESN, via its “Neurochemistry Initiative” Programme, has funded a Special Symposium at the Congress entitled “Early and Late Neurotoxic (Neurodegenerative) Signals” organised by Prof Andrzej Szutowicz (University of Gdansk, Poland).
