Following the success of the initiative at the Tartu meeting in 2015, the joint ISN-ESN 2017 meeting in Paris, and the Milan meeting 2019, ESN will continue to provide early career ESN members with a platform to present their exciting research results as a talk at an international conference. Early career, current ESN members (PhD students in the final phase of their PhD and postdocs who finished their PhD in 2018 or more recently) are invited to apply for a talk at the ESN Young Members' Symposium (YMS) at the **ISN-ESN 2022 Meeting from August 8 to 11, 2023**, in Porto, Portugal.

To apply for ESN YMS please send an abstract (max. 250 words) for your proposed oral presentation, a recent CV including publication list and a supporting letter of the PhD/Postdoc supervisor to ESN Secretary Professor Illana Gozes (igozes@tauex.tau.ac.il) **before February 1, 2023.**

ESN Council will evaluate the applications and all applicants will be notified by February 10, 2023. ESN members who are selected for a presentation at the YMS will receive financial support from ESN covering meeting registration + lodging at the student accommodation for the duration of the meeting + economy travel to Porto upon ticket presentation, in total up to 800 Euros.

Upon notification, all abstracts will have to be submitted through the meeting portal, with a deadline of **February 15, 2023.**
